

Improved Touring Everything: ITE-O and ITE-U

Colorado Region 2008

Concept: Improved Touring Everything: Over and Under. ITE-O and U follows Improved Touring class specifications found in the GCR. ITE-O is for cars over 3.0 liters of engine displacement and ITE-U is for cars less than 3.0 liters. There is an adjustment factor for turbo and super-charged cars of 1.4 times displacement to determine theoretical displacement for classification purposes.

Rules: Please refer to the current year GCR for preparation rules. All cars must conform to General Competition Rules specifications for Improved Touring Preparation. ITE in Rocky Mountain Division is divided into two groups. All cars must carry either class designation ITE-O or ITE-U. ITE- O for those cars over 3.0 liters of engine displacement and ITE-U for those of less than 3.0 liters. Further, for non-normally aspirated cars (super-charged or turbo-charged) a multiplier of 1.4 will be used to determine final displacement for classification purposes. engine size will be rounded up to the next closest 1/10 of a liter.
