Regional Class Only

FCS

1. Definition

Club Ford is designated as a regional only class. Eligible Cars are Formula F cars manufactured prior to January 1, 1984. With the following exclusions: Swift DB-1. Any Club Ford not in compliance with the above requirements must compete as a Formula F for the entire event. All Club Fords cars must comply with the SCCA rules applicable to Formula F in the current GCR.

2. Tires

Tires must be run in sets of 4 as stated below:

American Racer Formula Ford Tires: Compound 133

Front: 20.0 x 6.0-13S

Rear: 22.5 x 7.5-13S or

Wet compound tires are open.

3. Class Designation

All cars shall display CF as the class designation.

4. Majors Events

Club Fords may participate in Majors events as Formula F(s). The Club Ford class administrator (or his designated representative) will compile a unique finishing order of Club Ford compliant cars to the Division point's keeper after each Majors event.
