

COVID-19 MITIGATION PLAN

For

La Junta Raceway, May 9, 2020

The published SCCA Road Racing Race Safe Guidelines will be followed for this event. The purpose of this supplement is to present a concise checklist that specifically details how both the SCCA Guidelines and Colorado guidelines will be implemented at the May 9th event.

1. All applicable items in the SCCA Road Racing, Safe Guidelines, will be implemented and should be referenced by all participants and staff.
2. Each car will be assigned a pit that is a minimum of 10 feet preferably 20 feet from any other pit.
3. All meetings including Driver's Meeting and Workers Meeting will be conducted by using the Public Address system or by using a megaphone while participants maintain the prescribed social distancing standards.
4. Registration will be held outside if weather permits. In the event of conditions that dictate that registration be in the main building, the number of occupants will be kept to fewer than 10 with social distancing being maintained.
5. Sanitation processes will be IAW the SCCA document.
6. Lunch will be pre-ordered with one person at a time picking up. Social distance will be maintained. No eating at picnic tables. Participants will eat in their pit area.
7. Pit/Grid personnel will do a visual of safety equipment from a safe distance. Each driver is responsible for ensuring safety equipment is being properly utilized.
8. Trophies will not be presented but will be made available at a prescribed place and will be picked up by the driver.
9. Personal sanitizers will be given to each participant at registration for use at the event.
10. Participants and staff are encouraged to bring their own masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, folding chairs, coolers and drinks.

We are all looking forward to getting on the track and thank Victory Motorsports, the City of La Junta and Otero County for their cooperation in making this both a safe and fun event.
