

VINTAGE FORD [VF]**Vintage Class Only**

FCS

1. Definition

Vintage Ford is designated as a regional only class. Eligible Cars are Formula Ford cars manufactured prior to January 1, 1982 and meet the requirements of the SCCA Vintage GCR. Any Vintage Ford not in compliance with the above requirements must compete as a Formula F for the entire event. All Vintage Ford cars must comply with the SCCA rules applicable to Formula Ford in the current SCCA Vintage GCR.

2. Tires

Tires are open. It is recommended to run any of the 3 options in sets of 4 as stated below:

American Racer Formula Ford Tires: Compound 133

Front: 20.0 x 6.0-13S

Rear: 22.5 x 7.5-13S

Hoosier: R60A Compound

Front: PN: 43130, 20.0 x 6.0-13

Rear: PN: 43307, 22.5 x 7.2-13

Hoosier: Vintage Formula Ford

Front: PN: 44165 135/545-13

Rear: PN: 44170 165/580-13

Wet compound tires are open.

3. Engine

The only permitted engines are:

- a. The Ford 1600 GT "Kent" pushrod "crossflow" as installed in the Ford Cortina in 1971 and later. The Kent engine specifications are contained in (FC/FF) B.12.
- b. The Ford 1600 GT "Cortina" engine as installed in the Ford Cortina through 1970. The Cortina engine specifications are contained in (FC/FF) B.13.

4. Class Designation

All cars shall display VF as the class designation.
